



MILITARY SERVICE

The documents kept at the ANOM only concern the military service of French citizens

ALGERIA

Military recruitment service number registers:

- **French citizens with common law civil status** [Civil Code] (including naturalised by Decree) recorded **in Algeria**. (A Frenchman born in Algeria but recorded at the age of 19 in the Var will figure in the registers of this department).
- **French citizens with local law civil status** (Muslim) who opted for French nationality **after 1962** (period of the option: 1963 to 1967).

The registers were kept by **Recruitment Office** (Algiers, Constantine, Oran) and by **class** (= year when the age of 20 was reached; as an example: conscripts born in 1900 belong to the class of 1920).

NB: Conscripts are not included in alphabetical order in the register but by service number. It is, therefore, necessary to consult the **alphabetical table** of the office and class beforehand to find out the number of the conscript sought.

- *These tables are micro-filmed. There is a directory with free access in the microfilm room (Series 94 MIOM).*
- *Most of the registers are micro-filmed (Series 142 MIOM). The directories are supplied by the reading room president.*
- *To consult the registers or their micro-filmed copies, it is necessary to fill in an authorisation form with the reading room president.*

The military authorities deliver about one class per year. Currently the latest registers received concern the class of 1940 (= born in 1920).

- For later classes (born after 1920), see the CAPM (Centre des Archives du Personnel Militaire) (e.g. BCAAM Bureau central des archives administratives militaires).
- For citizens with local law civil status (Muslim) who did not opt for French nationality after 1962: see the CAPM (e.g. BCAAM Bureau central des archives administratives militaires).
