



The Archives Nationales d'Outre-Mer (Aix-en-Provence) makes the Ulysse database available to you, allowing access to the digitised images of documents belonging to the image library and the map library. The purpose of this database, which was started in 2002, is to make photographs, isolated or in albums, postcards, posters, maps and plans, drawings and engravings, consultable on the Internet progressively.

This collection, exceptionally rich in information on the first and second French colonial empires, comes from public archives (Secretariats of State and Ministries which ran the colonies from the XVIIth Century to the XXth Century, General Governments, etc.) and from private archives, coming either from donations, acquisition, legacies or dating. It concerns very diverse countries.



Depending on his/her subject of interest, the Internet surfer can make a search using several criteria (authors' names, place names, period, etc.). On the screen he/she will see images of all the documents corresponding to his/her request. Being able to consult on-screen photographs, maps and plans, and postcards concerning the former French colonies is a superb facility offered to the researcher.

The database will be enriched progressively by digitisation campaigns and entry of data.
